

INTRAVASCULAR CONTRAST MEDIA POLICY

All administrations of intravascular contrast material should be directed by a radiologist or other appropriately trained physician throughout the procedure.

A **physician must be immediately available** to respond promptly and furnish assistance and direction to an adverse event and should have appropriate training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and management related to intravascular contrast material administration.

This does **not** mean that the physician must be present in the room where and when the procedure is performed.

I understand and will abide this directive for IV contrast media administration. I further understand that I should contact my DiagnosTemps supervisor in the event I should ever be requested to perform an exam in violation of this policy.
