The incumbent's primary responsibilities are in the performance of Magnetic Resonance Imaging examinations. Provides a variety of MRI examinations according to established protocols and/or verbal/written instructions of a Radiologist, this may include administration of contrast media. Assists Radiologist and receives patient, explains method of procedure, positions patient, selects and sets technical factors, sets up and adjusts accessory equipment according to the type of examination being performed, making adjustments when necessary to accommodate the needs of the patient. Monitors patients during and after the procedure, informs physician if changes in the patients condition occur. Checks medical records to insure patient identification and required documents are in order. Performs image capture, retrieval, and archiving functions as needed. In addition to receiving client feedback from DiagnosTemps, performance evaluations will be performed on a biannual basis.
