

Mammography

Performs all radiographic procedures and functions as the Mammography Quality Control Technologist as needed and directed by customer. Operates radiology equipment; supports radiologist or other medical officers to produce mammogram studies used to diagnose medical conditions. Receives and interprets requests or instructions for procedures; secures the confidence and cooperation of patients; explains procedures, positions patients; varies procedures or position to adjust for patients' medical conditions; determines technical factors, sets controls and operates equipment; performs darkroom duties, and maintain supplies; cleans and sterilizes equipment and area after use; performs routine maintenance and recognizes and reports malfunctioning equipment to ensure its repair; makes minor adjustments to equipment such as setting up wedges or changing traverse length adjusters; determines technical factors (i.e., calculates the correct exposure factors of time, distance, kilovoltage, and milliamperage), sets controls and operates equipment ensuring that the portion of the body specified receives the correct calculated exposure; maintains records of patients treated, examination performed and scans taken. In addition to receiving client feedback from DiagnosTemps, performance evaluations will be performed on a biannual basis.
