

Special Procedures/ Cath Lab

Provides care to assist Interventional Radiologist in Specials Radiology procedures. Ensures Radiation safety. Administers IV contrast in a surgical/radiological setting. Radiation Safety Incumbent is assigned to the Special Procedures section of Imaging Service, and regularly performs procedures of a difficult nature involving operation of complex computer controlled x-ray equipment. Performs the following complex procedures: computerized digital subtraction angiography; transfemoral aortography; transfemoral visceral angios; renal angiography; transfemoral and axillary pulmonary angiographies; transfemoral subclavian and bronchial angios; venacavagram; transfemoral and axillary cerebral and vertebral angiograms; all balloon emboliazations, transfemoral dilatations, transluminal angio-plasty; all regular and magnified automography; all biopsies and cyst punctures; lymphangiograms. In addition to receiving client feedback from DiagnosTemps, performance evaluations will be performed on a biannual basis.
